## **Written Examinations**

Grade examinations in Theory of Music, Musicianship and Music Craft (except Grades 5 & 6) available online.

Traditional paper-based exams for all Theory of Music grades and diplomas available on application. A school or private studio with a minimum of ten candidates may apply to host paper-based Theory of Music examinations at any convenient time from March through to November.
